

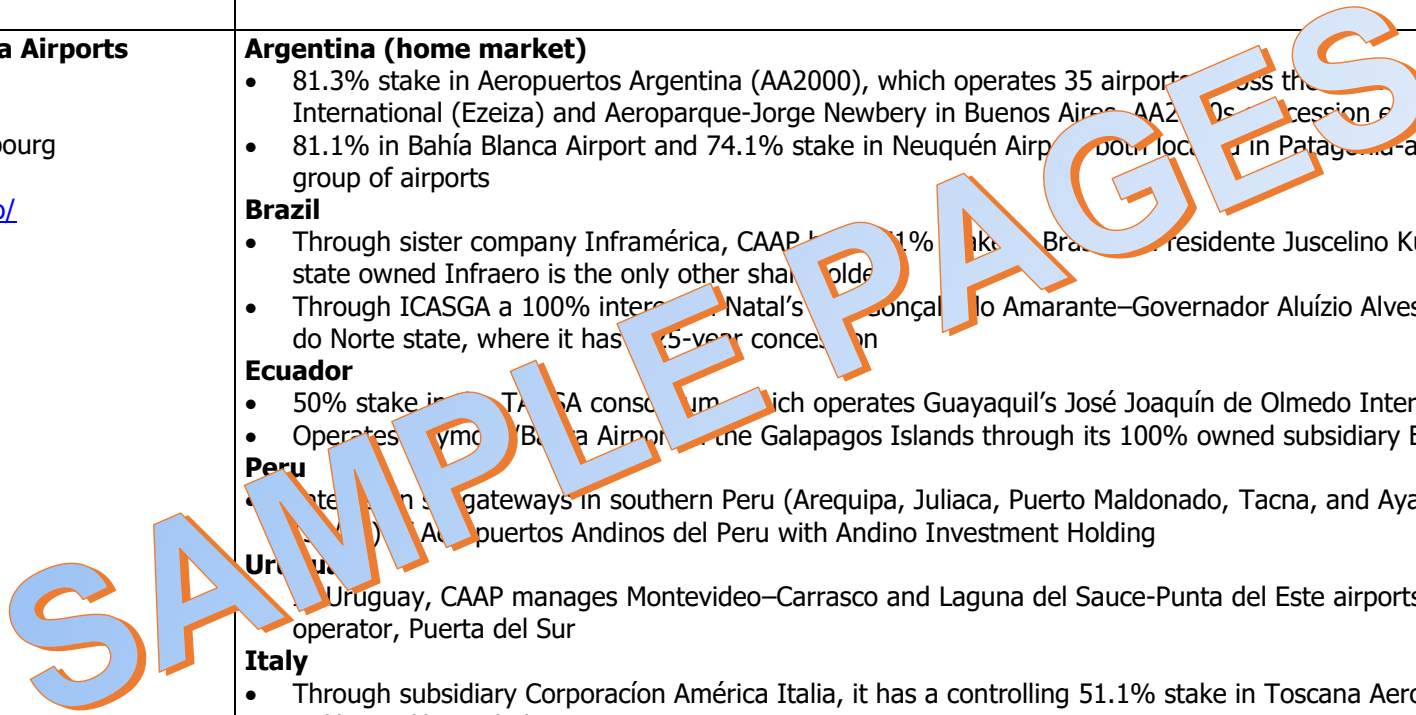

<p><b>Corporación América Airports (CAAP)</b></p> <p>Headquarters: Luxembourg</p> <p><a href="https://www.caap.aero/">https://www.caap.aero/</a></p>	<p><b>Argentina (home market)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>81.3% stake in Aeropuertos Argentina (AA2000), which operates 35 airports across the country including Ministro Pistarini International (Ezeiza) and Aeroparque-Jorge Newbery in Buenos Aires. AA2000 has concession agreements in 2038</li> <li>81.1% in Bahía Blanca Airport and 74.1% stake in Neuquén Airport, both located in Patagonia and which are not part of AA2000 group of airports</li> </ul> <p><b>Brazil</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Through sister company Inframérica, CAAP has a 51% stake in Brazilian Presidente Juscelino Kubitschek International Airport (where state owned Infraero is the only other shareholder)</li> <li>Through ICASGA a 100% interest in Natal's Governador João Amarante–Governador Aluizio Alves International Airport in Rio Grande do Norte state, where it has a 15-year concession</li> </ul> <p><b>Ecuador</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>50% stake in TASA consortium which operates Guayaquil's José Joaquín de Olmedo International Airport (expiry: 2029)</li> <li>Operates Seymour Airport on the Galapagos Islands through its 100% owned subsidiary ECOGAL</li> </ul> <p><b>Peru</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Operates 4 air gateways in southern Peru (Arequipa, Juliaca, Puerto Maldonado, Tacna, and Ayacucho) due to its joint ownership with Andino Investment Holding</li> </ul> <p><b>Uruguay</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In Uruguay, CAAP manages Montevideo–Carrasco and Laguna del Sauce–Punta del Este airports through its 100% ownership of operator, Puerta del Sur</li> </ul> <p><b>Italy</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Through subsidiary Corporación América Italia, it has a controlling 51.1% stake in Toscana Aeroporti SpA, the operator of Pisa–Galileo Galilei and Florence–Amerigo Vespucci airports in Tuscany</li> </ul> <p><b>Armenia</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Through subsidiary, Armenia International Airports CJSC, CAAP also manages Zvartnots Airport in Yerevan and Shirak Airport in Gyumri</li> </ul>
